Trident College is delighted to announce that the class of 2025 has confirmed their potential and produced another excellent set of results in the challenging Cambridge International AS and A Level curriculum, with many pupils demonstrating outstanding results and progress. The Year 13 cohort produced a **100% pass rate at A Level**, reflecting the grit, determination and commitment to academic growth that are hallmarks of Trident College. A **quarter of all grades were A or A***, and **75% were achieved at grade C or above**. Candidates taking Further Mathematics, Geography and Computer Science recorded 100% of grades at C or above, with strong outcomes also in Chemistry (85%), Business Studies (83%), and Maths and Physics (both 80%).

At AS Level, our Year 12 stepped up the performance from 2024, with a **5% increase in both the number of A grades awarded (25%) and grades at C or above (62%), and an overall pass rate of 91%**. Modern Foreign Languages deserves particular commendation, with 100% of AS Level French and Spanish candidates achieving grades C and above. Given that this was also our **biggest ever cohort (91 pupils)**, these grades are representative of the hard work and dedication of our teaching staff, the maturity and application of our pupils, and the support of our wonderful parents.

Confirmed destinations for the Class of 2025 include **UNZA, University of Cape Town, Stellenbosch University, Loughborough University, University of Pretoria, Curtin University and University of New South Wales**. Pending applications include **Yale, Harvard, University of Pennsylvania, Brown University, Leicester University, University of Toronto, and University of Western Australia** to name but a few. Trident College remains committed to supporting our alumni as they step out onto the global stage, ready to thrive and make a meaningful impact.
