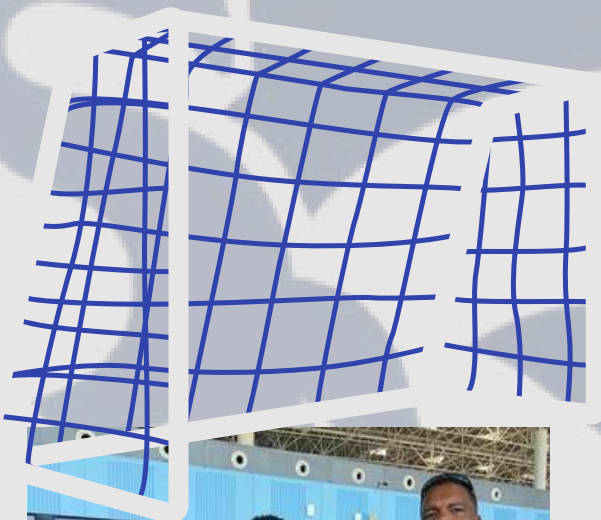
Deyaz plays for Zambia

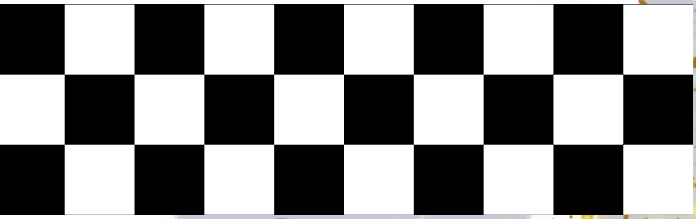
The netball regional tournament was held at Trident College. Leveraging their home court advantage, the team performed exceptionally well and successfully advanced to the nationals.

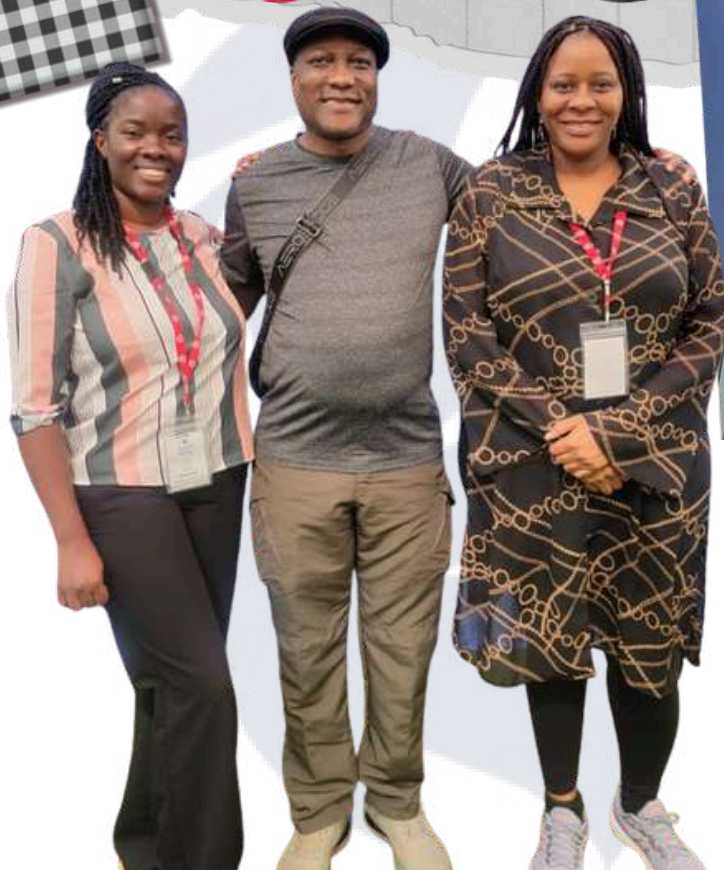

Model United Nations: Dubai Edition



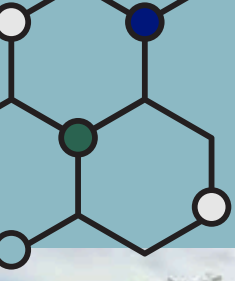

Murals are like colourful decorations and important tools for expressing ourselves. They can totally change the vibe of a school, making it feel more welcoming and inspiring for everyone.

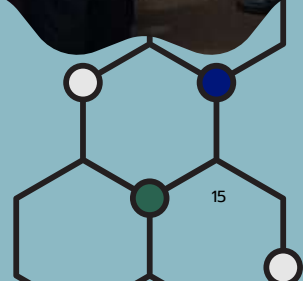




YEAR 12 SCIENCE TRIP
