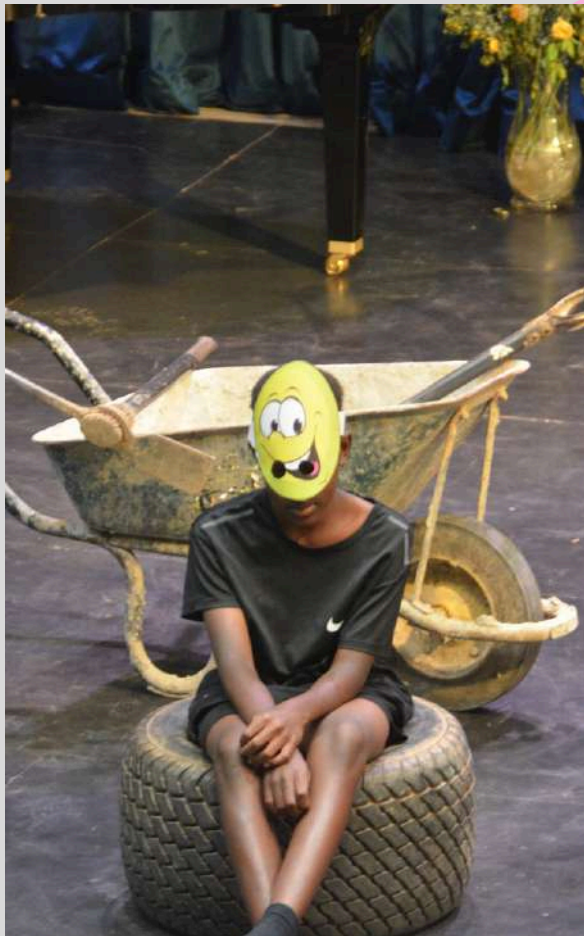
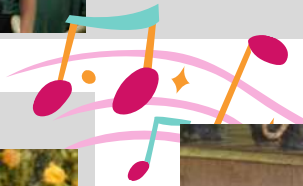
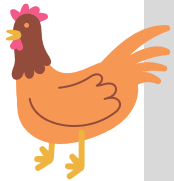


YEAR 7 INDUCTION

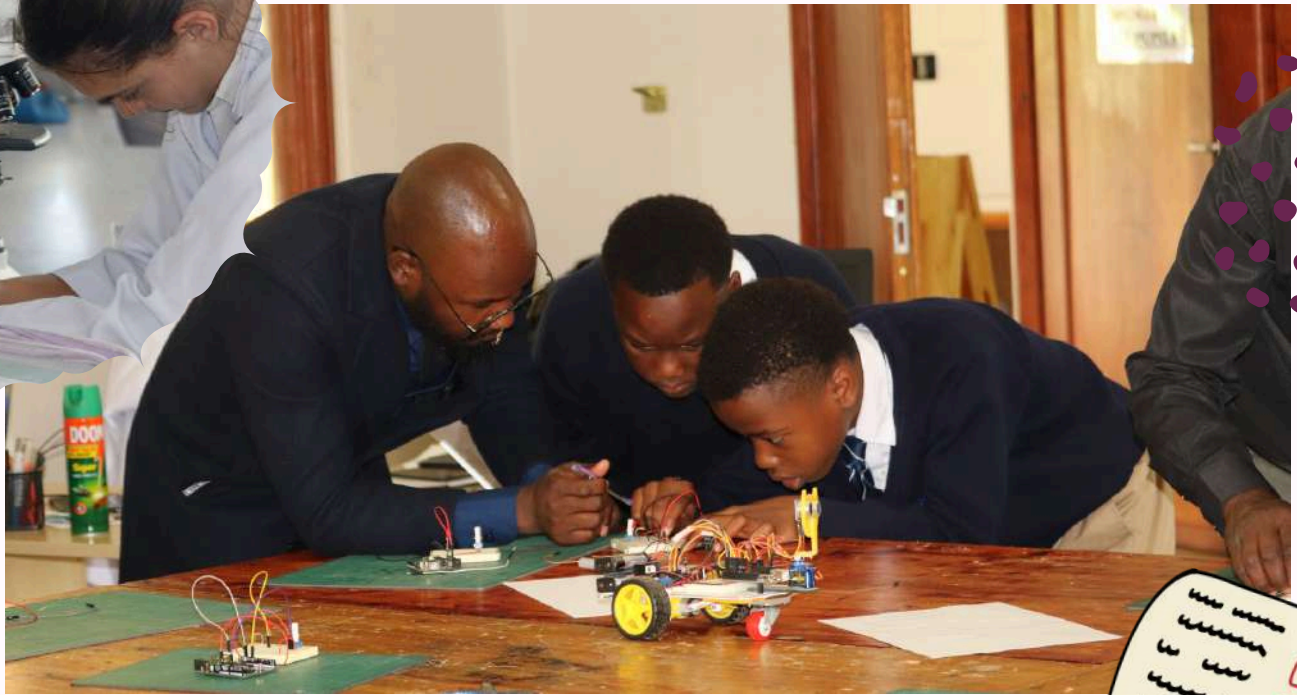

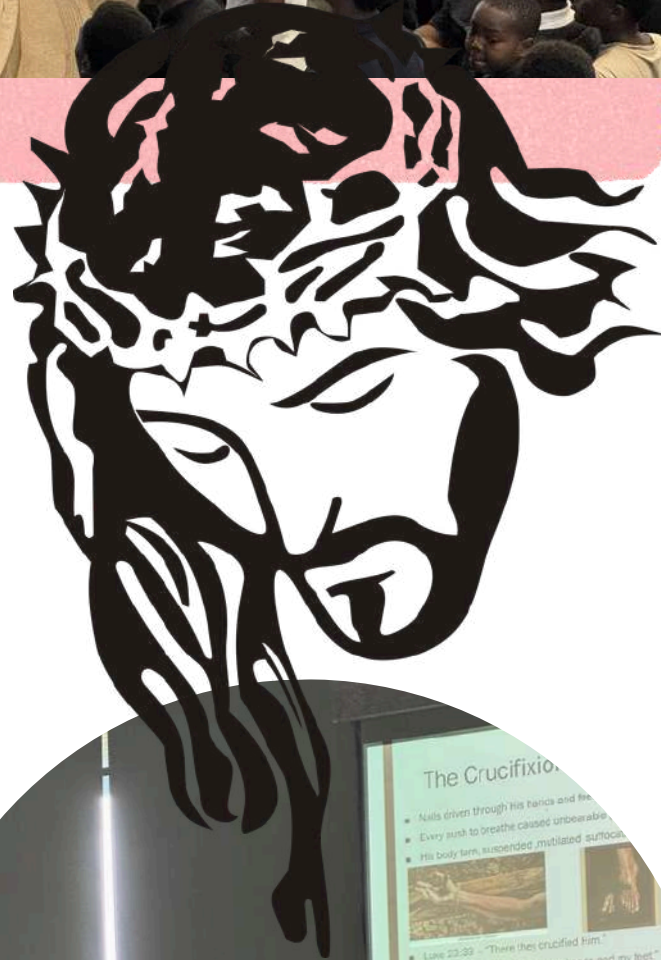


EASTER WEEKEND

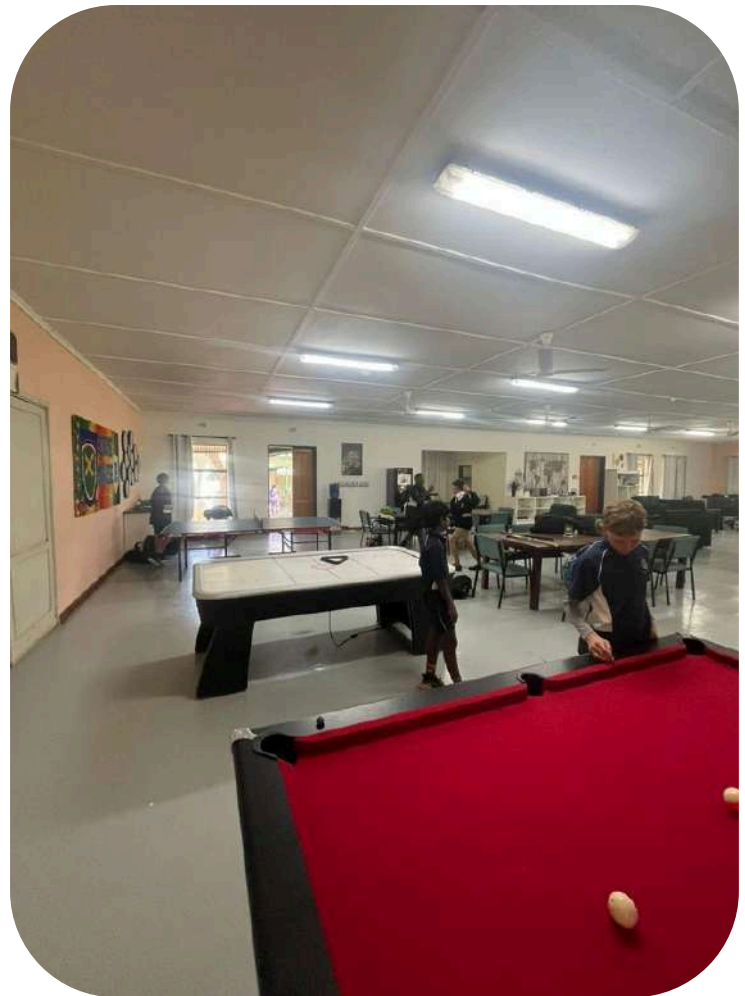




COBRE
