Trident College is a Cambridge International boarding and day school for pupils from Year 7 to Year 13. Set on a 113-hectare nature reserve in Solwezi, Zambia, the College forms part of Trident Schools, operated by Educare Services. The role is based at Trident College, with regular visits to the Prep campuses to support student wellbeing and Learning Support provision across the group.
